CHAPTER 1

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOUR ARRIVAL IN BARCELONA

ARRIVAL

Josep Tarradellas Barcelona-El Prat Airport is the main gateway to the vibrant city of Barcelona and is located just 12 kilometers southwest of the city center. It's one of the busiest airports in Europe, but don't worry, we've got you covered!

The airport has two terminals, Terminal 1 (T1) and Terminal 2 (T2), which are connected by a convenient shuttle bus service that runs regularly. Getting to the city center is also a breeze thanks to reliable public transportation options, including trains, buses, and taxis.

When you arrive, be sure to take the Aerobus, the popular shuttle bus service that'll take you directly to Plaza de Catalunya, a central square in Barcelona. The journey usually takes around 35 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

To ensure your trip is as smooth and stress-free as possible, we recommend checking the airport's official website or contacting your airline for the latest information on flight schedules, terminal assignments, and any specific travel requirements or restrictions.

FESTIVAL VENUE

The World Trade Center Barcelona is a prominent complex strategically located in the Port of Barcelona. It provides easy access to transportation networks and international trade routes.

There are several options to reach the World Trade Center Barcelona:

Public Transportation: The venue is well connected to the city's public transportation system. You can take the metro or bus to reach the World Trade Center. The closest metro station is Drassanes (Line 3). From there, it's just a short walk to the venue. Bus lines D20, H14, and V13 also stop near the World Trade Center.

Taxi and private car services: If you prefer, you can easily take a taxi or private car service to the World Trade Center.

TIMETABLE AND TICKETS

Saturday, November 18th from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Sunday, November 19th from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

This year, there are four types of tickets available for the Barcelona Knits Festival: Saturday, Sunday, Sunday (with reduced hours from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.), and the weekend pass.

You can purchase tickets in advance or directly at the box office on the day and time of the festival. Just a heads up, there might be some queues for those who buy tickets on-site. It's important to note that having a pre-sale ticket doesn't give you priority access, it's simply a discounted ticket.

To enter the festival, you must exchange your tickets for a personal and non-transferable wristband. You can collect your wristband on Friday from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. at **Lalanalú** (c/ Martínez de la Rosa, 71) or at the box office on the day of the festival.

When you collect your wristband, the festival staff will put it on for you, and you need to keep it on for the duration of the event. Just a friendly reminder that you're not allowed to collect someone else's wristband.

All workshops include entry to the festival on the day of the workshop, except for Stephen West's virtual conference.

The Cast On Party, the exciting event that kicks off Barcelona Knits 2023, is already sold out!

We'll cast on for the <u>Tile hat</u>, the featured pattern for this edition by <u>Sònia Torner</u>. She and the team from <u>El Robledal de la Santa</u>, the dyers of the original wool, will be joining us. Nara from <u>KnitLeaks</u> will interview them online, revealing the secrets behind their creations.

The event will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. at **Loft de Gracia** (c/ de Montmany, 30). The nearest metro station is L4 Joanic, and the venue has a bar where you can buy drinks like water, soft drinks, and beer.

To attend the Cast On Party, reserve your spot and exchange your Barcelona Knits advance ticket for a non-transferable wristband. Pick up your wristband on Friday at **Lalanalú** (c/ Martínez de la Rosa, 71) from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. To collect your wristband, either present your printed ticket or the QR code on your mobile device. The wristband will only be given to the ticket holder in person.

To enjoy the party, bring your project bag, needles, crochet hooks, and DK yarn. That's all you need to kick off the wool party in style!




